Summary: Maintenance Worker and General Laborer OJT position requires a minimum of 30 hours per week, Monday through Friday and/or nights and weekends. - Maintain exterior appearance of houses and offices as directed
- Able to receive and act upon verbal and written directions in a timely and efficient manner
- Must be able to stand/sit/walk for extended periods of time, while lifting, carrying, bending, kneeling, crawling, climbing
- Clean and clear debris, brush, waste, and potentially hazardous materials
